Our Aim: is to make the world more welcoming for people with understanding or speaking difficulties



We want to raise awareness of, and improve access for, people with receptive and expressive language impairments (or understanding and speaking difficulties), one of the most overlooked areas of disability in our society.



In the UK alone, difficulties in understanding and using the spoken and written word affect:

- Over 1 million people with learning disabilities
- Around 700,000 on the autistic spectrum
- Around 850,000 people with dementia (rapidly rising)
- Over 350,000 people who have had a stroke
- Up to 50,000 people who have a brain tumour and many many more.

Yet there is little support outside overstretched speech and language therapy services.



Communication is two-way. Without skilled and inclusive communication partners, people with understanding and speaking difficulties are at risk of isolation, loneliness and mental and physical health issues.



Include.org provides training, consultancy and community activities to teach inclusive communication skills to individuals and organisations across the community, improving access to the things we all take for granted.
