We make some walks wheelchair accessible - always check before booking.



Learn about inclusive communication in nature



During our walks, we stop and sign things we see. This is great to practice and learn new Makaton signs.



We take photos or videos to help people learn and remember the signs.



We use the photos and videos to make a Chat Book. The Chat Book explains what we did on the walk with words, pictures and videos - and teaches some signs.



Everybody helps to make the Chat Books, using an app called Pictello.



People with communication difficulties use the Chat Book to tell others about the walk!
