#### 1) What date is Halloween?

Halloween is always on the **31<sup>st</sup> October**.









# 2) What **vegetable** do we often see Halloween?

#### **Pumpkins!**

On Halloween we hollow out pumpkins, carve scary faces on them and put candles inside to make lanterns.

Pumpkins are an **American tradition** (there are lots of them at this time of year, ready for making Pumpkin Pie for Thanksgiving).

In the **UK**, we traditionally carved lanterns from **turnips or swedes** (but that's much harder work!)

3) Who could turn from a **man i**nto a **bat** (and liked **drinking human blood**)?

**Count Dracula** – from the **book** of the same name, written by Bram Stoker, and published in 1897















#### 4) What does the word Halloween mean?

Halloween was originally called **All Hallow's Even**. It was **shortened to Hallowe'en** a long time ago, in the sixteenth century.

All Hallow's Even' meant the **night before All Hallow's Day** on November 1<sup>st</sup>.

All Hallow's Day is the old name for All Saints Day which is a Feast Day to honour all the Christian Saints.

## 5) Which **fruit** do you traditionally 'bob' for at Halloween?

#### Apples!

The game means trying to get **apples out** of water without using your hands! It has been around since Roman times.

Although apple bobbing is now something we do at Halloween – it was originally all about love and romance!

In the original game, the apple represented someone you loved, if you picked up the apple in teeth in one bite – you would be lucky in love, but 3 tries or more and your love was doomed!
