Many studies tell us that people feel happier when they think more about the good things they have in their life.



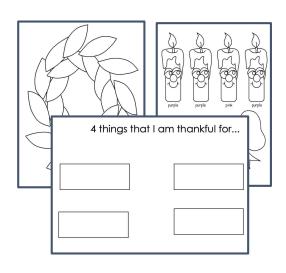
At Christmas, people think a lot about the things they want to get and forget about the good things they already have.

Paper wreath decoration instructions



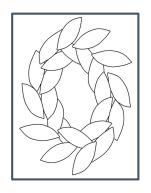


Print out the **template** page of these instructions.



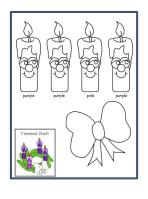


Get your **colour pencils** ready.





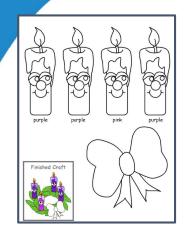
Colour your paper wreath.





Colour the candles and bow.



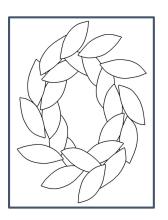




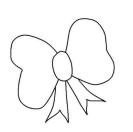
Cut your coloured candles and bow.



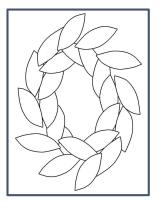




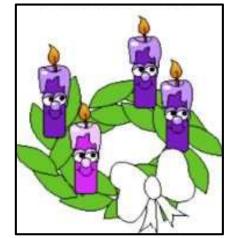
Glue the candles to the paper wreath.







Glue the bow to the paper wreath.

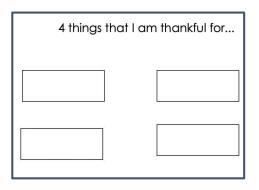


Now it will look like this!



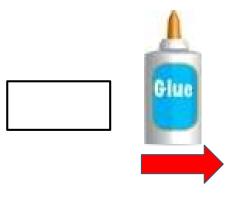


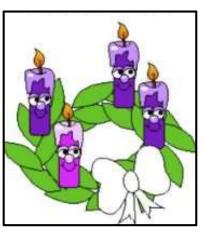
Write 4 things you are grateful for.



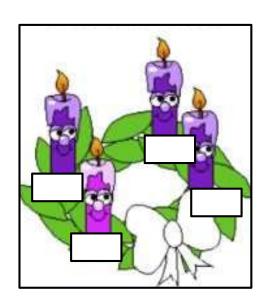


Cut each rectangle.

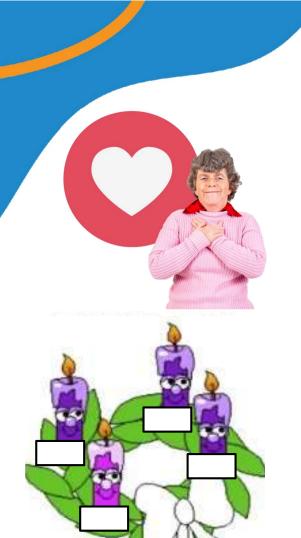




Glue the rectangles to the base of the candles.

Remember! Gratitude helps you **feel good** and be **happy**.

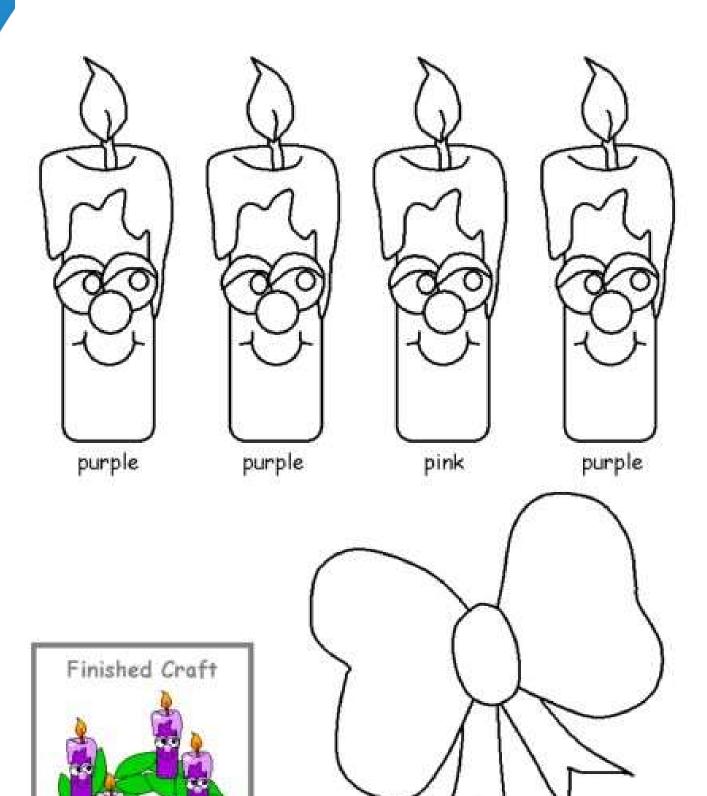
So don't forget to **look** at your **decoration** to **remind yourself what you** are **grateful for**, this Christmas.

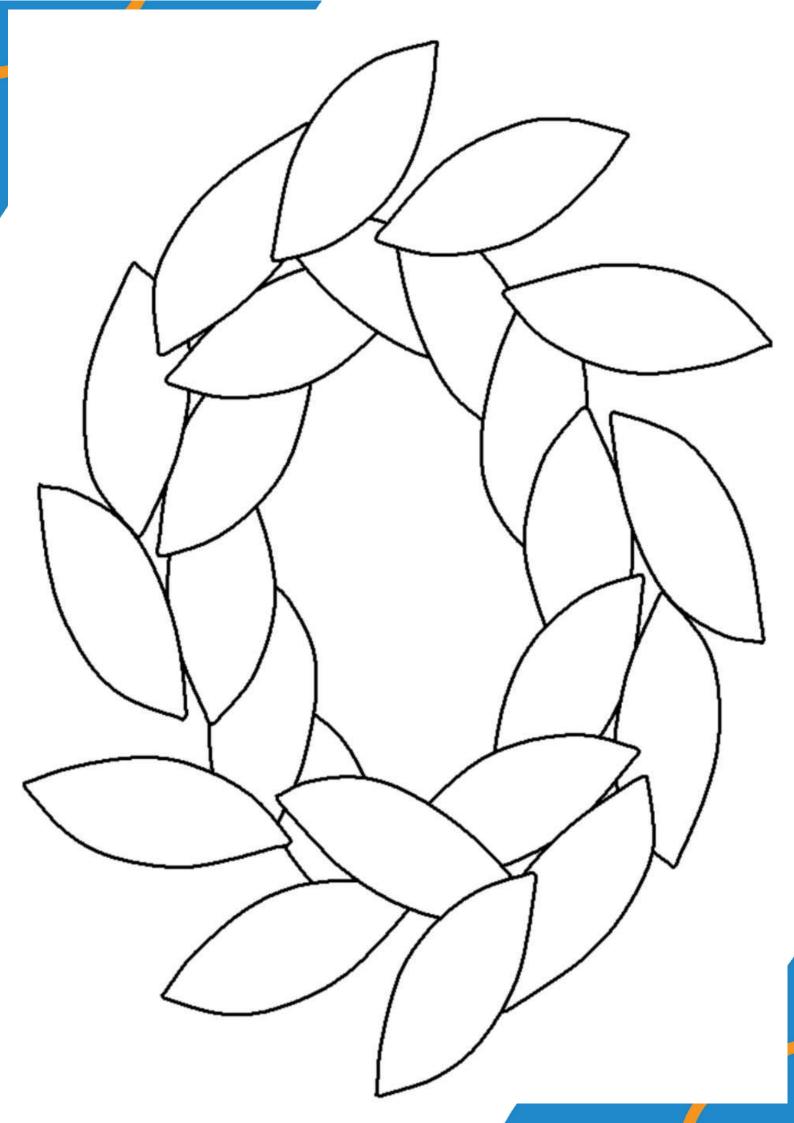
