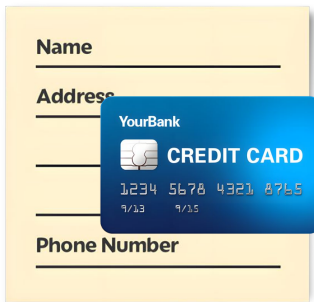


What did we talk about last week?



Last week, we **talked about Phishing attacks.** A Phishing attack is **when someone sends fake emails that look real to trick you to give personal information.**



Personal information is any **detail** that can **identify you**, like your **name, address, phone number, passwords, or bank details.**



Phishing attacks can **also be fake text** messages or **fake phone calls.** These text messages or phone calls **look real to trick people to share their information.**



It is **very important** to **never give** your **bank account details** or **passwords** to **anyone online** or **over the phone.**



When you are not sure about a text or phone call, **ask someone you trust for help.**



You can also **look up** the **company's real phone number** online and **call them to check.**
