

Bridge Building Challenge





Include is asking people to do a fun Bridge Building Challenge with small things you have. For example, you could use Lego or lolly sticks to build a bridge.






The team challenge is for people to build a bridge together without speaking or writing words.



Team 1



Try to make 2 teams with the same number of people. This way you can have a fun competition.



Each team will **build** a **bridge** with a **base** of **30cm or more**.



The team that builds the <u>tallest</u> bridge will win.



This challenge will help you notice the different ways people can communicate and include people. Not just with words.



Get Ready To Build



Bridges can be built from things like **Lego**, **lolly sticks**, **dry pasta**, **blutac and tape**. Choose what you will use. **Each team needs the <u>same</u> things to build their bridges**.



You also need:

A paper and pencil for each team.



A ruler or tape measure.

• A stopwatch or timer to make sure each team has the same amount of time. Try 15 minutes.



 You can balance your finished bridge between two chairs or tables.
