

What did we talk about last week?



Last week, we **had** a **person** from **parliament** come to **talk** to us **about** what the **parliament** is and **how** we **can talk** with our **local Member of Parliament (MP)**.



We said that there are **650 MPs**. MPs are **voted for** by **adults** in the **UK** in a **big vote**. This vote is called a **general election**.



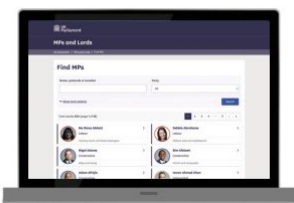
MPs **come** to the **UK Parliament** to **debate**. This **means** they **talk about ideas** and **problems together**. Like how to get more people into jobs.



Idea MPs also **meet people** in their **local area** to **hear** about **ideas** or **problems**. MPs can then talk about your ideas in parliament.
