We **said** that **sometimes people raise** their **voices** to **loved ones** because they **get** really **emotional**, **worried** or **angry** about **something**.



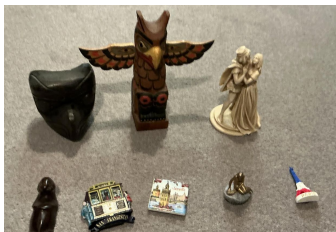

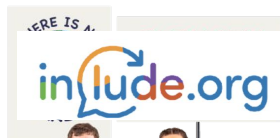
We said that **assertive communication** happens when **people tell others** what they **need** in a **nice way**.
